12. Special help is needed for 12 students at Rogue Valley Adventist Academy. Our present enrollment, including these 12, is 136 students. Our budget was based on 135 students with a certain grade level make up. We have fewer upper graders and high school students than projected, so our total income is less than planned. We have 38% less student aid available this year than last. During registration we were not able to guarantee these 12 students any assistance, but hoped our enrollment would allow enough income to help them. We went out on faith and registered them, and they are in school now. Bottom line - we need "special" funds for these students over and above all the other commitments we are responsible for. This is a valley wide appeal to all the Adventist churches in the RVAA constituency. We need your help to raise \$30,000 to keep these students in school this year. The school board and committees are working hard to recruit new students and renew efforts to build up the foreign exchange program, along with providing a stronger music presence in our community. The Medford Church Board voted unanimously to support this effort. Please mark your donation "RVAA Special Fund." Thank you for making Adventist Christian education available for those who want it.
